## **A. SERVICES FOR SHIPS CALLING**

### **1 SHIP-GENERATED SCRUBBER WASTE**

A fee for reception of waste from ships is charged in accordance with Swedish legislation and EU Directive 2000/59/EC.

Scrubber waste **SEK 1 100 for classification and administration per occasion, as well as actual cost of disposal**

### **2. FRESHWATER**

Per tonne or part of tonne **SEK 35**  
Minimum fee per delivery **SEK 630**  
Connection fee **SEK 380**

In the case of water supply outside normal hours of work, an additional hourly fee for personnel is charged in accordance with A.5. In the case of abnormal interruptions to water supply to the port, a fee will be charged for the actual additional costs.

### **3. ELECTRIC POWER**

Energy consumption **SEK 1.20/kWh**

There is an additional hourly fee for connection of electric power in accordance with A.5.

### **4. SERVICE BOATS**

Service boat **SEK 1 100/h**

Service boats must always be operated by two persons from port personnel. A fee for personnel expenses is payable in addition to the service boat fee, in accordance with A.5.

### **5. OIL TERMINAL SERVICES AND OTHER SERVICES**

Normal working hours (weekdays 07.00–15.30) **SEK 589/h per person**

Other times except major public holidays **SEK 1 092/h per person**

Major public holidays by agreement **SEK 1 426/h per person**

Port personnel work 12-hour shifts (start of shift 07.00 and 19.00). A deferred start of shift must be approved by the port.

## 6. BOATMEN AND MOORING SERVICE

For the oil terminal, normal prices are raised by 30% after normal hours of work. The fees relate to two persons. A fee is charged for further personnel in accordance with A.5.

Berth shifting along a quay is counted as arrival. Berth shifting from one quay to another is counted as departure and arrival.

### Ordering of boatmen

Monday-Friday 07.30–16.00: port office, telephone +46 (0)911-23 21 30.

Other times: Båtmanstjänst i Piteå AB, telephone +46(0)70-527 21 00.

If the ship arrives or departs more than 30 minutes after the ordered time, a fee is charged for waiting time in accordance with A.5.

A boatman obligation applies to all ports. In exceptional cases, exemptions may be granted by the port management.

If a mooring boat is required or ordered, a fee is charged in accordance with A.4 and A.5.

## 7. TUG ASSISTANCE

Restrictions for tug assistance at Piteå Port & Hub can be found on the National Maritime Administration website:

Tug assistance is offered during the ice season (1 January to 15 April). During that period there is a tug at the quayside for icebreaking of the port's channel. A fee is charged for towing in the channel up to the quay and for berth shifting at the quay.

During other times of the years the supplier of tug assistance should be contacted directly.

## **B. RAILWAY TRACK FEES**

### **8. TRACK FEE**

- 8.1 A track fee is charged for traffic on the railway infrastructure administered by Piteå Hamn AB. Information on applicable track fees can be found in the document Description of Railway Network.
- 8.2 Emission line fee  
Emission fee for locomotives and railcars operated with liquid or gaseous fuels arriving at or departing from the port by rail  
50 SEK per locomotive/railcar
- 8.3 Siding fee  
Siding fee on all managed tracks is charged after three days counting from date of arrival  
SEK 50/day per car

## **C. STORAGE OF GOODS**

### **9. RENTAL PROVISIONS**

#### **9.1 General rental provisions**

For intermediate storage, putting into store and parking of goods, rent is charged in accordance with C.9.2.

- Seven days are generally given free for arriving and departing goods handled on a designated space within the logistics area.
- Covered space is provided subject to availability.
- Cargo is surveyed and charged for monthly.
- Started months and parts of months are charged as whole months.
- The largest used space, including necessary free spaces such as safety zones, driving routes and cordoning-off materials during a month constitutes the basis for charging.
- Pads, reinforcements, support plates or similar are required for goods that impose a load of more than 10 tonnes/m<sup>2</sup> (100 kN/m<sup>2</sup>) on the ground. A separate fee is charged for this.
- The tenant of the storage space must bear the cost of and provide the following:
  - Cleaning and tidying during and after the rental period.
  - Necessary snow clearance and traction-control for unloading, loading, storage, etc.
  - Ordinary operations and maintenance needed for the tenant goods handling such as dust suppression, sweeping and similar
  - Insurance of deposited goods.
- Piteå Hamn AB cannot be held liable for damage, loss, etc. of stored goods.

## 9.2 Price list for storage services

The following supplements will be added for goods stored for more than 6 calendar months, counting from the date of arrival:

- 100% on the storage price after 6 months.
- 200 % on the storage price after 12 months.

## D. OTHER PROVISIONS

### 10. OTHER PROVISIONS CONCERNING OPERATION

- 10.1 Seven days are generally free for intermediate storage of arriving and departing goods handled on a designated space within the logistics area.
- 10.2 A day is counted from 00.00 to 24.00.
- 10.3 Normal hours of work (Monday to Friday) are considered to be 07.00–15.30.
- 10.4 Prices in accordance with this price list apply within the area of operation of Piteå Port & Hub and the railway infrastructure managed by Piteå hamn AB.
